PARISH DISCOVERS PROMOTING ONLINE GIVING INCREASED DONORS BY 70%

Prince of Peace Catholic Community in Plano, Texas, has proven that it's never too late to start doing something new. A parish that boasts more than 2,400 households, they realized that there were more giving opportunities within their parish than they were currently receiving, and all they had to do was find them.

Sue Mann is the Children's Religious Education Assistant for Prince of Peace Catholic Community and WeShare coordinator for the parish. They first began to use WeShare in 2013 as a way to accept payments for their various programs and ministries, such as marriage preparation, elementary and high school youth groups, and religious education classes.

"The first few years, the focus was to use the WeShare online giving program specifically for registration," Mann explained. "Right from the beginning, the response from our parish members was excellent. We didn't introduce the idea of online giving to our parishioners until we were invited to participate in the engagement program this past year."

Last year, LPi tested a pilot program for current WeShare customers that was designed to increase online donors and maximize parish giving through proactive marketing. For the Prince of Peace Catholic Community administration, this was the first time they ever sent out an email communication targeted to their parishioners about the ease of online giving and the benefits to the parish.

As an added service to the parish, LPi sent back a cleaned-up version of their contact list, which includes the removal of expired or inaccurate emails, for additional utilization by the parish.

Reflecting on the process, Mann is pleased with the outcome thus far.

"I thought it was a great first step into our new venture in online giving," said Mann as she reflected on the results. "We knew that getting people to not only become online donors, but to actually become recurring donors, would greatly benefit our parish.

"There are so many reasons why people don't always give, and most of the time, it's not because they are hesitant or unwilling," she said. "The reasons tend to be that they simply forget to bring their envelope, they attend a different church, or just go out of town for a weekend. By eliminating those roadblocks, people have no more reasons not to give."

As part of the program, the parish also made sure to utilize WeShare posters and pew cards, added information to the weekly bulletin on how to sign up, and made announcements before Mass. According to Mann, the results have been impressive, and they're not slowing down any time soon.

When the parish started participating in the engagement program in July 2018, there were 148 donors in their WeShare program. As of January 2019, 103 new recurring donors have been added for a total of 251. This 70% increase projects an estimated yearly increase of more than \$217,000 — and it all results from some well-timed reminder emails and printed materials to match.

"We are very pleased with the way that people have been able to use the WeShare system. It works out really well," Mann said. "We're excited to see what kinds of results we'll have with online giving as the program continues to progress."
